- Can industry self-regulation be an effective response to tin sourcing concerns?

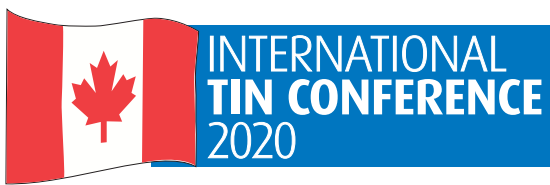
The session will see experts across the tin value chain sharing the latest reporting and communications strategies that are shaping the future of responsible business in the tin industry.
