



13th International Tinplate Conference 2025

London, 9-10 September 2025

Call for Papers

The International Tin Association (ITA) is pleased to announce that the 13th International Tinplate Conference will be held in London, UK and take place on 9-10 September 2025.

Held every four years, since 1976 it is well respected in the industry as a unique forum for tracking market and technology changes in tinplate. Due to COVID this will be the first opportunity for the tinplate industry to gather in person for nearly a decade.

The event attracts delegates from across the supply chain, including tinplate producers, traders, analysts, can makers, lacquer suppliers, equipment and electrolyte suppliers. The last conference in London in 2016 attracted over 125 delegates from twenty-seven countries.

The two-day event will include presentations and Q&A sessions on Market Trends, Tinplate Innovations, End-User Perspectives, Sustainability, Technical Developments and Future Challenges & Opportunities. There will be a networking dinner and in the session breaks there will also be networking opportunities through social lounges and exhibitor/sponsor booths.

ITA invites authors wishing to present a paper to submit a title and short abstract of about 400 words in English, providing sufficient information for a fair assessment.
