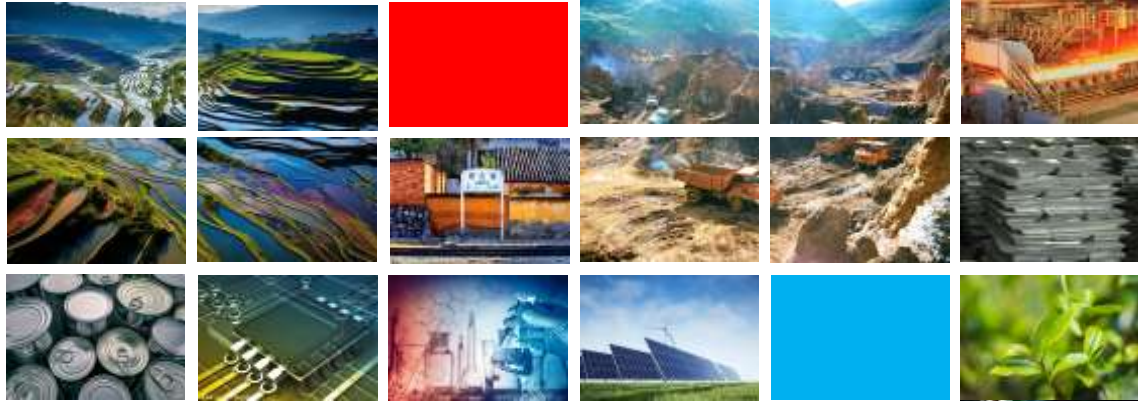

Tin Connects the World, Powering the Future

After nine years, Asia Tin Week will return to Kunming this November.

Yunnan Province is home to several major tin smelters, and Kunming, its capital, sits at the heart of China's tin industry as the headquarters of the world's largest tin producer, Yunnan Tin. The previous Asia Tin Week in Kunming, held in 2017, attracted around 300 delegates, one third of them were international participants.

Since then, the global tin supply chain has undergone profound transformation. Asia has consolidated its position as the driving force in both supply and demand. China, Indonesia, Malaysia, and Thailand remain key producing countries, while China, Japan, India, and South Korea collectively account for over 45% of global tin consumption. At the same time, the green transition is accelerating the reshaping of the tin consumption structure, demand highlights are emerging in areas such as solar ribbon, electric vehicles, and semiconductors. The immense potential of artificial intelligence has opened up broad growth space for the industry, significantly boosting medium- to long-term demand expectations. Against this backdrop, supply-side constraints are increasingly becoming a focal point for the industry. How to build a resilient and sustainable tin supply chain in Asia and globally, and how to strike a balance between national resource strategies and free market mechanisms, will be key topics for discussions at this conference.

Asia Tin Week is a strategic meeting point for the entire tin value chain to reconnect with partners, forge new collaborations and engage with industry leaders.
